Other Requirements	<p>(1) Students must be enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate degree program at their home university during the semester. (2) Student must be a student of participating universities for the Campus Asia Plus Program. (3) Students must have a good academic record. *GPA2.3 or above in 3-point scale.</p>
